

### Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

The eligibility criteria for Admission into Under Graduate 5-year B. Arch. course shall be as mentioned below;

- i. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
- ii. The candidate should satisfy 'local'/'non-local' status requirements as laid down in the A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974, as subsequently amended.
- iii. No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with atleast 50% marks in aggregate."
- iv. The candidate should have qualified at National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) /JEE (Main) Paper - II and should also have secured State Architecture Rank (SAR). All candidates who come with a passing valid score of NATA-2019/JEE (Main)-2019 Paper - II, at the time of "**Certificate Verification**" will alone be considered for seat allocation under the convener Quota of seats.

**Note:** *For candidates who appeared in both NATA and JEE (Main) Paper - II Examination, SAR shall be prepared on the basis of higher percentage of the two scores.*
